- Step 1: Release locking handle and extend operating handle to maximum length and lock it in place.
- Step 2: Connect auger bit and secure with locking pin.
- Step 3: Adjust handle for angle drilling requirements, for maximum performance and safety place bit perpendicular to drilling surface.
- Step 4: For forward rotation squeeze right side of control handle and left side for reverse, release handle for neutral.
- Step 5: While drilling periodically lift auger up and remove dirt from the hole.
